**As A Camper, I Will:**



- Behave appropriately and promote a safe, friendly, fun, and healthy environment.
- Be respectful, cooperative, and will contribute to the positive experience of fellow campers
- Be considerate of my actions and conduct myself responsibly. I understand that horseplay, unwelcomed teasing/bulling, inappropriate touching, or any unkind behavior will not be tolerated and will be grounds for dismissal.
- Communicate in appropriate manner, which means I will not use ANY foul language, gestures, or harsh words. I will not use any verbal threats of any kind.
- Refrain from deliberately causing bodily harm. I understand that pushing, kicking, hitting, or fighting are not acceptable behaviors and can be grounds for dismissal.
- Adhere to all safety rules & regulations given for each activity that he/she participate in while at camp.
- Show respect to ALL staff members, and fully cooperate with their directions at all times.

**DRESS CODE:**

- Every camper is REQUIRED to arrive to camp with socks & shoes on their feet.  
PRO TIP: longer sport socks work the best. Socks that do not cover the ankle, are most likely to cause blisters.
- Skate Factory follows School District dress code regulations.  
Clothing must be the proper size and fit appropriately. Shirts must completely cover the abdomen, back, & shoulders, with no midriff showing. Shorts/Skirts/Dresses must be below the fingertip length. Please NO sagging pants, ski masks, clothing with gang affiliation, profanity or offensive language.
- Campers will NOT be permitted into camp if otherwise

**SAFETY & GENERAL:**

- All campers are REQUIRED be signed in or out of camp, by a parent/guardian ONLY. Adults may be ask to show valid identification. We highly recommend your camper(s) arrive to camp prior to 9:30am to participate in our morning meetings. Please note, other groups will begin to arrive at this time. To avoid traffic, arrive prior to 9:30am.
- Skate Bags or Backpacks are highly recommended, for keeping any & all of your child's personal belongings together in a safe place. It is not recommended for campers to bring any valuable personal belongings to camp. Skate Factory is not held responsible for any lost or stolen items.
- Change of clothes is recommended for younger campers, as we have many spills on clothes, accidents, or ripped clothing.
- If you are wishing to give your child extra spending money, we recommend using our Player Cards. Any amount is able to be placed on card. Player Cards are kept with staff members at all times and are assigned strictly to your camper only. Player Cards can be used for food, drinks, games, and more!
- FOOD ALLERGIES: Lunch, Morning, and Afternoon snacks are included in the camp cost. However, if your child has a special diet, they may bring a lunch or snacks from home.
- PROHIBITED items include: gum, slime, nail polish, pillows & blankets, weapons, any objects to intimidate or threaten others or damage property.
- Staff members will work with individual campers to modify inappropriate behaviors and will notify parents when necessary. Camper Director may choose to dismiss camper(s) if behavior does not improve.
